

PROTECTING YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY

IN AN EMERGENCY LISTEN TO KNX 1070 FOR ALL THE INFORMATION YOU NEED TO KEEP YOUR FAMILY SAFE.

- Create and practice a family disaster plan including how you'll reunite or communicate if separated.
- Build an emergency supply kit for your home, car and office.
- Update your kits every 6 months to make sure food is fresh and medications have not expired.
- Prepare your children and practice role-playing.
- Consider family members with special needs, such as the elderly, people with disabilities or non-English speakers.
- Learn CPR and First Aid.
- Eliminate hazards in the home.

YOUR MONEY & DOCUMENTS

PREPARE YOUR FINANCES FOR AN EMERGENCY WITH KNX 1070 AND MONEY 101.

- Scan important documents so they can be stored on a computer far from home or at a secure online location.
- Keep your personal info on password-protected USB flash drives that you can keep with you or in your emergency kit.
- Keep copies of bank account numbers, credit card numbers, driver's licenses, Social Security cards, prescriptions (medicine and eyeglasses or contact lenses) and immunization records.
- Original car titles, tax records, stock and bond certificates, deeds, wills, trust agreements, birth and marriage certificates, passports and insurance policies are best kept in bank safe deposit boxes.
- Keep a video record and inventory of your household possessions and property and keep copies of appraisals.
- Make a small list of items you'd take with you if you have time in an evacuation, such as laptops or external drives containing important records, jewelry, heirlooms, mementos, photos or your child's favorite toy.
- Keep emergency cash or travelers checks in a safe, accessible place. ATMs might not work in a disaster and stores may not be able to issue change.

KEEPING YOUR PETS SAFE

KNX 1070 TRAFFIC AND WEATHER TOGETHER ON THE 5'S AND EMERGENCY SHELTER INFORMATION AT cbsLA.com.

- If evacuated, don't leave your pets behind.
- Not all disaster shelters can accommodate pets so make a list of preferred kennels and boarding facilities.
- Identify motels and hotels outside your immediate area that accept pets.
- Make sure your pets wear collars and ID tags.
- Keep recent photos of your pets in case you are separated.

Keep an emergency kit for your pets, including:

- 3-7 days of canned or dry food and water.
- Aluminum roasting pans for disposable litter trays.
- Waste bags, litter, paper towels and disposable garbage bags.
- Feeding dishes and toys.
- Extra collars, harnesses and leashes.
- Photocopies of pet records and vaccinations.
- A 2-week supply of any medication.

EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT

MAKE SURE KNX 1070 IS PART OF YOUR EMERGENCY PLAN.

- A gallon of water per person per day for at least 3 days for drinking and sanitation. Store additional water for pets.
- At least a 3-day supply of non-perishable food for each person and pet.
- Mess kits, paper cups and plates, and plastic utensils.
- Manual can opener for food.
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio to monitor **KNX 1070** traffic, weather and emergency information.
- Flashlights and extra batteries.
- Fire extinguisher.
- First Aid kit and First Aid book.
- Dust mask.
- Plastic sheeting and duct tape to create a shelter.
- Infant formula, diapers and moist towelettes.
- Garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation.
- Cell phone with chargers, inverter or solar charger.
- Prescription medications, extra pairs of glasses and/or contact lenses.
- Acetaminophen, ibuprofen and children's medications.
- Cash or travelers checks and loose change.
- Important family documents.
- Sleeping bags or warm blankets for each person.
- Change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes.
- Rain coat or poncho.
- Matches in a waterproof container, candles, flares and whistles.
- Toiletries including soap and shampoo, toilet paper, feminine hygiene supplies and hand sanitizers.
- Shovel, axe and rope.
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities.
- Paper, pencils, books and games or toys.

YOUR CAR

WHEN THE EARTH SHAKES, COUNT ON KNX 1070 FOR EMERGENCY INFORMATION, ROAD CLOSURES AND THE MOST FREQUENT TRAFFIC UPDATES.

- Keep an emergency kit in your car in case you're stranded.
- Never let your gas tank fall below ¼ full.
- Keep a pair of old, comfortable shoes and spare clothes in your vehicle.

AT WORK

GET BREAKING NEWS TEXT ALERTS FROM KNX 1070. JUST TEXT 'NEWS' TO 41070.*

- Create a crisis communications plan.
- Practice your plan with employees and/or colleagues.
- Review your insurance policies.
- Keep a basic emergency kit handy, including water, a flashlight, spare batteries, a First Aid kit, a radio, gloves and a blanket.

COMMUNICATING DURING AN EMERGENCY
